

Information and Student Recruitment for Online Japanese Language Class (1st Stage)

To everyone who wants to learn Japanese:

Due to the influence of the new coronavirus, our classroom lessons cannot be resumed yet. We will do small start the online Japanese class from September. This time, two Japanese classes are announced as the 1st stage (see note at the bottom).

(1) Conversation Intermediate Class

Date and Time: Every Saturday, from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Contents: Study expressions that are often used in daily conversation and discuss various topics from news shows and newspapers.

Textbook: No textbook required.

Required Japanese Level: Be able to have daily conversation (self-introduction, greetings, etc.)

Class Days: Sept. 19, 26, Oct. 3, 10, 17, 24, 31, Nov. 7, 14, 21, 28, Dec. 5, 12, 19 (total 14 Classes)

Student Capacity: About 30

Application Period: Between Sept. 10 and 16.

Method for Result Notification: Email is posted with the result that you can attend or not between Sept. 17 and 18.

(2) Conversation Elementary Class

Date and Time: Every Thursday, from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

Contents: Practice conversation by picking up familiar scenes such as shopping at a supermarket, ordering at a restaurant, and how to get on a train, etc. Introducing Japanese sites of the Agency for Cultural Affairs and the Japan Foundation, so you can prepare and review at home.

Textbook: No textbook required.

Required Japanese Level: Be able to have simple daily conversation and read hiragana

Class Days: Oct. 1, 8, 15, 22, 29, Nov. 5, 12, 19, 26, Dec. 3, 10, 17 (total 12 Classes)

Student Capacity: About 10

Application Period: Between Sept. 18 and 27.

Method for Result Notification: Email is posted with the result that you can attend or not between Sept. 28 and 30.

2. Foreign person who lives, works, or studies in Kashiwa.
3. After attending the classes, who can participate in the international exchange activities in Kashiwa.
