Information and Student Recruitment for Online Japanese Language Class (Start from November)

To everyone who wants to learn Japanese:

Due to the influence of the new coronavirus, our classroom lessons cannot be resumed yet. We will increase 3 classes as online lesson in and from November.

(1) Minna no Nihongo Primary I Class

Date and Time: Every Tuesday, from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

Contents: Speak daily life, what you can do or cannot do, hobbies, experiences, etc. (Start from Lesson 16 in the textbook)

Textbook: "Minna no Nihongo Primary I Issue 2" (3A Network)

Required Japanese Level: Be able to understand simple Japanese (verb variants)

Class Days: Nov. 3, 10, 17, 24, Dec. 1, 8, 15 (total 7 Classes)

Student Capacity: About 6

(2) Minna no Nihongo Primary II Class

Date and Time: Every Friday, from 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Contents: Become able to increase vocabulary, explain things in detail, and communicate your feelings in detail. Develop a comprehensive understanding of sentence. (Start from Lesson 27 in the textbook)

Textbook: "Minna no Nihongo Primary I Issue 2" (3A Network)

Required Japanese Level: Completion of "Minna no Nihongo Primary I"

Class Days: Nov. 6, 13, 20, 27, Dec. 4, 11, 18 (total 7 Classes)

Student Capacity: About 6

(3) Hajimeyou Nihongo Primary 2 Class

Date and Time: Every Thursday, from 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Contents: Conversation focusing on scenes and topics using sentence patterns. (Start from Lesson 14 in the textbook)

Textbook: Revised Edition "Hajimeyou Nihongo Primary 2" (3A Network) .

Required Japanese Level: Be able to understand simple Japanese (Primary II)

Class Days: Nov. 5, 12, 19, 26, Dec. 3, 10, 17 (total 7 Classes)

Student Capacity: About 6
